Good for those who would like to study Grammar in details and prefers a more traditional, academic approach with a considerable amount of self-learning. No images or illustrations. Beginners level.

Conclusion

Finnish Mobile applications

- Estimated number of language learning applications suitable for learning the Finnish language in top-rated list

In Google store and App store there are around 20 top listed apps in total. Most of the top rated language learning applications are created for studying multiple languages (Mondly, Duolingo and similar offer a large number of languages to learn within the same app frame).

- How many applications in total did you download on your mobile devices or PCs to complete this report?

For analysing the situation on the Finnish language app market, we downloaded 23 mobile application. In this report, we have provided analysis only for 14 mobile learning applications: 9 applications were not selected for this analysis as they had faults in them (the applications had poor or very limited content, had poor layout and functionality, etc.)

- How many applications did you analyse for this report?

In this report we analysed 14 mobile applications.

- How many of them had the support/translation in top 3 immigrant languages

5 of the analysed applications had Russian as a support/translation language. None of the analysed apps were available in Somalian or Estonian, while 3 applications had Arabic as support language.

- How could you summarize the available features of the applications you analyzed? Which features do you find most useful for learning Finnish? Which of the features would you recommend?

- Illustrated material/images: In general, it would be beneficial to use illustrated material as a support to the translations or instead of them in some exercises. The majority of the vocabulary exercises (especially nouns) should be illustrated.
- Audio: using audio would be considered a plus in case in the frames of the SFI project budget we could guarantee high quality of the recordings.
- Simple user interface and design

- Various exercises modes and gamified approach to the exercises shuffled letter exercise
- Additional content: none of the studied applications offered dialogues or any short text content in Finnish (only several exercises had short phrases material).

Thus it would be beneficial to have this content available in the app.

- Please summarize your comments on the application analysis (if any)

Most analysed apps offered limited selection of the vocabulary categories in the free versions, so it would definitely be a huge benefit for the language learners in Finland if SFI provided a mobile application with the expected material (2000-2500 items) available for free.

Swedish mobile applications

In Sweden there are a lot of applications for language learning but many are for children, around 150-200 applications. The applications for adults have increased this year and many have been developed in 2016 with various quality. In the top-rated list for language learning for adults there are around 15-20 applications.

For this report we downloaded and analysed 20 applications and 15 of them support the top immigration languages in Sweden.

- How could you summarize the available features of the applications you analysed? Which features do you find most useful for learning Swedish? Which of the features would you recommend to use in the SFI project application?

Many of the applications have following features:

- Photos
- Flashcards
- Sound
- Video - but often too big files

For the SFI project mobile application we recommend features such as Photos, Flashcards, match activity, they are the most appreciated features according to feedback from the language applications we analysed. The application should not be too big and videos are great, but take time to download and take too much space.
